2. Age limit: 35 years as on the date of walk-in -interview (SC/ST/OBC/Persons With Disability (PWD) are eligible for age relaxation as per rules).
3. Tenure of the JRF/ JPF will be initially for a period of One year and will be extendable on need and performance basis.
4. In case more number of candidates turn up for walk-in-interview there will be a subject oriented written test for duration of one hour and shortlisted candidates only will be interviewed on the same day itself.
5. Candidates should appear for written test/walk-in-interview in person with original certificates proving educational qualification, age, caste, experience etc., along with any other relevant information (like copies of publication, awards, recommendations etc.)
6. Candidates should enclose self-attested true copies of the relevant certificate/ testimonials along with the application and submit the same on the date of walk-in-interview.
7. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PWD should produce copies of the relevant certificates issued by the Competent Authority to that effect.
8. A 'No Objection Certificate' from the employer concerned is required in respect of those applicants who are employed under Central/State Government/Public Sector Undertakings/ Autonomous Bodies.
9. No traveling or any other allowances is admissible for attending the written test/walk-in-interview.

10. The Institute reserves the right not to fill up the position, if it so decides.
11. The Institute reserves the right to terminate the assignment at any time before completion of the appointment, if it so decides.
12. No interim correspondence will be entertained.
13. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
